



2022 Wales Motorcycle Federation Solo Enduro Championship

ET James Motorcycles sponsored 2022 Welsh Enduro Championship.

A competitor must be of proven Welsh birth, either or both parents of proven Welsh birth or have been a continuous resident in Wales for a period of not less than three years prior to the 1st January 2022.

Championship to comprise of:

1. Snowrun Enduro (WTRA) 6th February 2022
2. Jack Frost Enduro (Rhayader MCC & LCC) 27th March 2022
3. Drovers Enduro (WTRA) 17th April 2022
4. Welsh Two Day Enduro 23rd & 24th June 2022
5. Caio Enduro (DDBC) 6th August 2022
6. Rhayader 2 Day British Enduro (Rhayader MCC & LCC TBC)
7. Hundred House Enduro (Builth Wells) 7th September 2022

Classes are: Championship, Expert, Clubman, Ladies, O40's, O50's and Sportsman. If there are two Sportsman schedules in an event you must enter the higher class. This year it has also been decided to allow competitors who are not eligible to compete in the Welsh Championship to contend for the Non Welsh Championship Trophy but this will only be allowed in the Championship Class and not any other class.

This gives 9 days of competition with 7 days to count.

In the occurrence of events being cancelled we reserve the right to revoke the option for riders to drop their lowest scores.

In the event of a tie the best performance in the last round of the series will decide the winner.

Steve Plain Motorcycles sponsored 2022 U19's Welsh Enduro Championship.

This year the WMF Enduro Committee has agreed to run a championship dedicated to Under 19's. This is to be run on clubmen schedule and comprises of the following events: -

1. Jack Frost Enduro (Rhayader MCC & LCC) 27th March 2022
2. Drovers Enduro (WTRA) 17th April 2022
3. Caio Enduro (DDBC) 6th August 2022
4. Brechfa Enduro (DDBC) TBC
5. Early Bird Enduro (WTRA) 9th October 2022



This gives 5 days of competition with 5 days to count.

In the event of a tie the best performance in the last round of the series will decide the winner.

Please note that although this is an under 19's class ACU rules apply to the competitors, refer to the ACU handbook.

It is the **rider's responsibility** to gain entry to the events as organisers cannot guarantee an entry even though the event is in the Welsh Championship. **Please be mindful to get your entries in as early as possible!!**

This year due to the events being mandated to use transponder timing a levy of £1 per rider per event must be paid to the WMF Committee. If the levy is not received from each rider prior to the event then the rider will not be awarded the points that they earn for that event.
